

Crestmont Cruisers Running Club is a free, yearlong program for Kindergarten–5th grade students that encourages students to develop healthy fitness habits. The students run or walk at their own pace around a course on the playground. Parent volunteers track mileage. There is a built-in award schedule in which the cruisers can earn tokens and other awards. Each student that completes a marathon distance (26.2 miles) by May earns a Crestmont Cruisers Marathon T-shirt and an invitation to the Marathoners Breakfast!
