## Skate Night

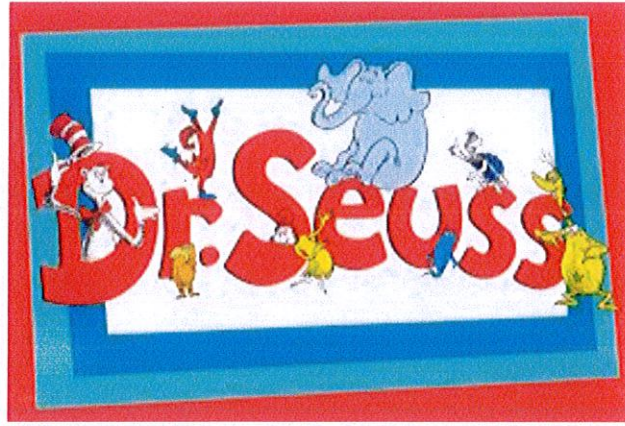
Thursday, March 28th is Skate Night at Roller King. Join us for a fun night of pizza and skating.

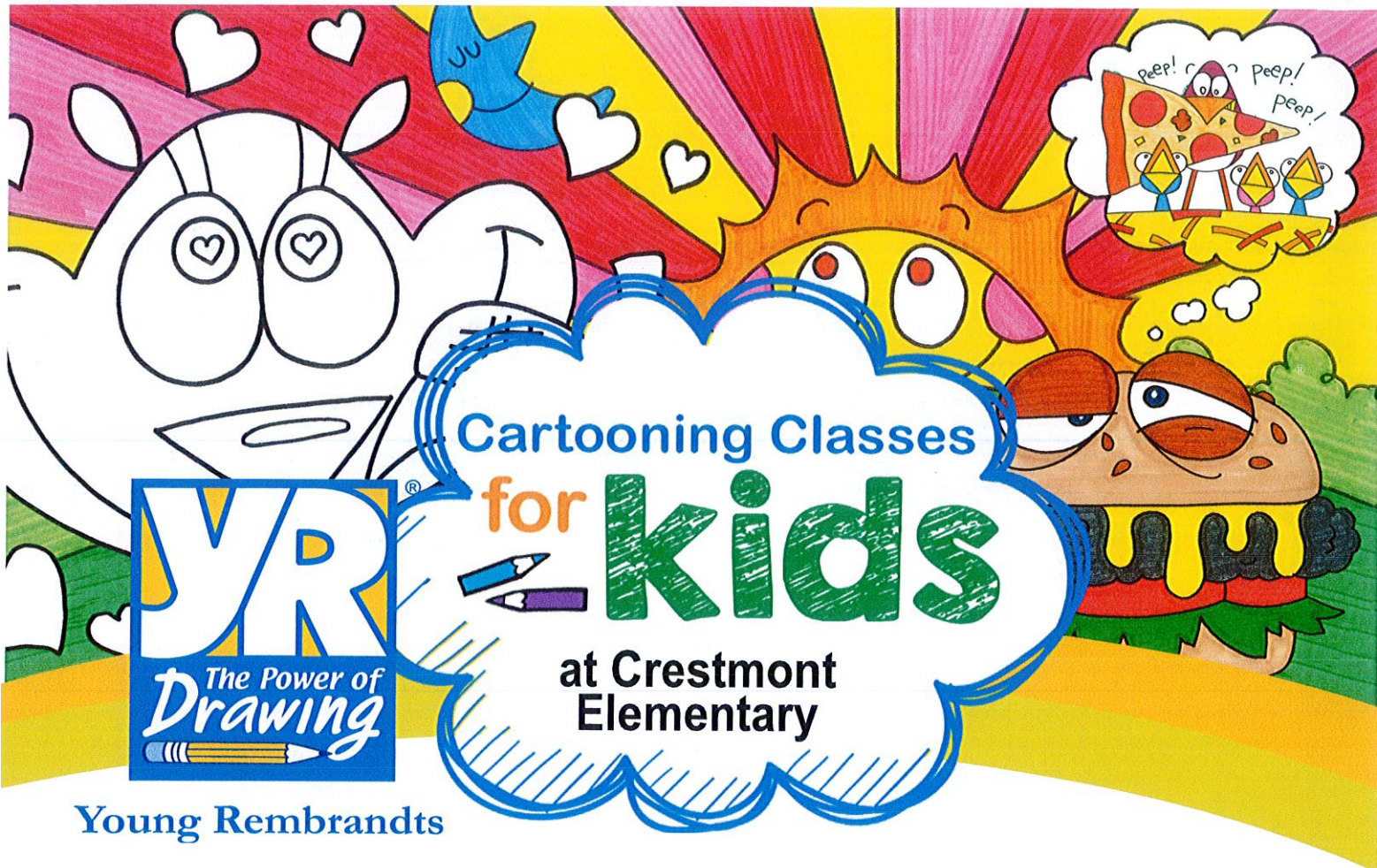


## **Saturday, March 2**

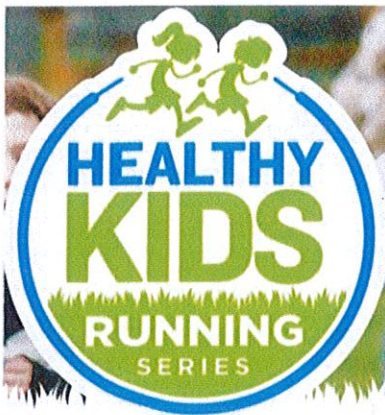
